#### The Admiral Fell Inn, Baltimore, Maryland

In the area originally settled by Quaker William Fell in 1726, this Inn consists of seven buildings, some more than 200 years old. Ghosts are said to pop up everywhere at this historic site—even showing up tableside while you're dining—which at various times was a Christian boardinghouse for seamen, a YMCA and a vinegar factory. Today the hotel offers ghost tours with spooky sightings stories.
